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## 1. Introduction

In the context of the IQPharm Project, a crucial aspect of fostering excellence in pharmaceutical education and practice is the development and implementation of relevant institutional regulations. This initiative is being undertaken collaboratively across various partner faculties and departments in Bosnia and Herzegovina (BiH). The primary focus of this endeavor is to facilitate the integration of Entrepreneurship Education and Ethics (EE/E) into the curriculum and practices of these educational institutions.

This report outlines the progress and objectives related to the development of institutional regulations within the IQ Pharm Project. It provides an overview of the initiative's scope, the specific goals to be achieved, and the significance of these regulatory developments in enhancing the quality and relevance of pharmaceutical education in BiH.

## 2. Objectives of the Deliverable

**Regulation Development:** The main objective of this deliverable has been achieved through the successful initiation of institutional regulations at all partner faculties and departments in BiH. These regulations specifically address the integration of Entrepreneurship Education and Ethics (EE/E) into the existing pharmacy curriculum.

**Utilization of Pilot Program Insights:** The deliverable successfully utilized the insights and data obtained from the successful pilot program implementation to craft well-informed and effective regulatory proposals.

**Proposal Formalization:** Comprehensive and substantiated proposals have been prepared and accepted, advocating for the mandatory incorporation of the EE/E platform within the institutional regulations of partner faculties and departments. These proposals are now formalized, outlining the necessity of EE/E and the steps required for compliance.

**Alignment with Existing Regulations:** The deliverable ensured that the proposed regulations are harmonized with existing institutional regulations and the broader national context, taking into account the specific needs of pharmacy education in BiH

## 3. Conclusion

In conclusion, Task 2.2.6 within the IQPharm project has been successfully completed, representing a crucial step towards improving pharmaceutical education in Bosnia and Herzegovina. The objectives of this deliverable have been achieved, facilitating the development of regulations that modernized the curriculum and aligned it with European standards and contemporary practices. By leveraging valuable insights obtained from the pilot programs, the project ensured that its recommendations are informed and practical. The Faculty of Pharmacy at the University of Mostar made a Decision on the implementation of project activities number: 09-01-144/23 dated February 23, 2023. The decision pertained to the implementation of project activities on OSCE and the electronic platform for professional practice, the E-platform.

The Faculty of Medicine at the University of Banja Luka adopted a Decision on the adoption of the Undergraduate Internship Program for students of the Pharmacy Study Program number: 18/3.404/23 dated May 12, 2023. The decision amended the Undergraduate Internship Program for students of the Pharmacy Study Program, introducing the EE platform for monitoring student work.

The Faculty of Pharmacy at the University of Sarajevo made a Decision on the implementation of the EE platform number 0101-1031/23 dated March 6, 2023. With this decision, the implementation of the EE platform began with the aim of digitizing and modernizing the monitoring and management of professional practice within the integrated study of I and II cycles at the University of Sarajevo - Faculty of Pharmacy.

The Faculty of Pharmacy at the University of Tuzla made a Decision on the implementation of the Erasmus project 'iQpharm' number 02/13-1384-1-8.1/23 dated March 10, 2023. The Scientific and Teaching Council of the Faculty of Pharmacy, among other things, decided to implement the EE platform aiming to digitize and modernize the monitoring and management of professional practice.
