1. Introduction

This marks a significant milestone in the project's journey towards enhancing pharmaceutical education in BiH through the integration of the EE/E platform.

2. Objectives of the Deliverable

The objectives of this deliverable task include:


- Eliminating all issues and shortcomings identified during the pilot implementation of the EE/E platform.
- Ensuring the technical and operational capabilities required for a seamless introduction of the EE/E platform.
- Successfully initiating the EE/E platform at all partner public universities in Bosnia and Herzegovina, signifying its widespread adoption and integration into the curricula of these institutions.

As part of this task, the IQPharm platform has been created. The IQPharm platform operates as follows:

Users access the platform via the link: www.iqpharm.ba, using their username containing the faculty domain and password.

The entire process is digitized, and a mobile application (web based) for the platform is also available.

After students log in, through the EE/E platform, they register their attendance at experiential education, take exams, create reports, and have continuous communication with professors through the platform.
